Sub: Monitoring of Reservation Policy and Development Programmes/Schemes implemented for Scheduled Tribes by the Hidayatullah National Law University.

Sir,

The National Commission for Scheduled Tribe (NCST), set up under Article 338A of the Constitution, is vested with responsibility, inter-alia, to investigate and monitor all matters relating to the safeguards provided to the scheduled Tribe under the Constitution or under any other law for the time being in force or under any order of the Government and to monitor and evaluate the working of such safeguards. The Commission is required to present to the President annually and at such other times as the Commission may deem fit, reports upon the working of those safeguards.

Now, this Commission has decided to conduct the Review Meeting on 19.06.2018 at 11.00 hrs. On that day, first the Commission will have a meeting ST employees/Association of University, meet ST students followed by Review Meeting with Vice-Chancellor, Hidayatullah National Law University, Raipur (Chhattisgarh). A Power Point Presentation on the subject may also be made by HNLU during Review Meeting.
