As you are aware, Article 338A of the Constitution, *inter-alia*, enjoins upon the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes to present Report to the President of India upon the working of the Constitutional safeguards for Scheduled Tribes and to make recommendations regarding measures that should be taken by the Union or any State for effective implementation of those safeguards and for the protection, welfare and socio-economic development of Scheduled Tribes. In pursuance thereof, the 3rd Report of the Commission for the year 2007-08 has been presented to the Hon'ble President of India on 29th March, 2010. A reference to this effect might have been received by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs from the President's Secretariat. However, I am enclosing a copy of the Report submitted to the Hon'ble President for information and record of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs. A CD containing soft copy of the Report is also enclosed for necessary action.

2. As required under Clause (6) of Article 338A of the Constitution, the Report of the Commission has to be laid in both Houses of the Parliament along with a Memorandum explaining the action taken or proposed to be taken on the recommendations and the reasons for the non-acceptance, if any, of such recommendations relating to the Union. Similar action has also to be taken while laying the Report in the Legislative Assembly of the State concerned, in relation to the recommendations concerning the State. Copies of this Report are, therefore, required to be sent separately to the concerned States. I shall be grateful, if immediate action is taken by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs for forwarding copies of the Report to the concerned State Governments and for laying this Report in both Houses of the Parliament alongwith the requisite Memorandum
