Subject: - Regarding complaint of Shri Mohan Lal Meena S/O Late Shri Ram Singh
Meena R/O H.No.5419, Laddu Ghati, Pahar Ganj, New Delhi - 110055.

Sir,

With reference to DCP/Vigilance, Delhi's memo No.F.24(72-C to 81-C)/07/Vig./22857/HA-CM dated 03.07.2007, on the subject cited above, I am to state that the complainant has alleged that during the night intervening 29/30.05.2007, when his wife alongwith their children were sleeping on the roof, at about 12.30 night, he saw two boys were sitting there and his daughter Kavita, aged 8 years was between them and S. Mahender Singh, aged 50-52 years tried to molest her. He cried and after hearing his voice, his wife woke up and his daughter was weeping condition came to him. The alleged persons started quarrelling with him and threatened to kill if he complained against them. He complained the matter to local police and SI Maruti Rao alongwith staff reached the spot. SI Maruti Rao obtained his signature on a blank paper and took the alleged persons with the assurance that he would take legal action against them. In this connection a case FIR No.344/07 has been registered against the alleged two boys and they were sent to the Judicial Custody but no action has been taken against the main alleged person i.e. S. Mahender Singh. On 31.05.2007 at 9.30 AM, S. Mahender Singh, his son Happy and 3-4 other persons threatened him to withdraw the case. They also abused him and his family members by using caste related words and also beat them. Gopal and Happy also pumped the breast of his wife and tore her blouse. When his sister tried to save them, they snatched her chain of 2.5 Tolas. The complainant had made a PCR call and in response, PCR van and local police reached the spot and took both the parties to PS Pahar Ganj. The complainant party was made to sit there upto 9.30 PM whereas second party was released. When the complainant party and their neighbours started making hue and cry, a case FIR No.349/07 has been registered but detail facts were not mentioned. On 02.06.2007, SI Maruti Rao alongwith 3-4 police personnel, S. Mahender Singh and his son Happy threatened to implicate him in a false case if he complained against them. On 06.06.2007 at 3.30 PM, SHO/Pahar Ganj, SI Maruti Rao, 5-6 policemen, S. Mahender Singh, his son Happy and 4-5 others threatened him to withdraw the case otherwise he would be arrested in a false case. He has requested for necessary action.

Enquiry conducted through ACP/P.G. Cell revealed that the complainant and alleged S. Mahender Singh are tenants in the same premises. Their landlord is not residing there. On 30.05.2007, the complainant alongwith his wife Smt. Poonam and daughter Kavita, aged 8 years reached PS Pahar Ganj and stated that during the night intervening 29/30.05.2007, two boys Ranbir and Avinash tried to molest her daughter

Kavita. On his statement, a case FIR No.344/07 dated 30.05.2007 u/s 354/506/34 IPC PS Pahar Ganj has been registered and both the alleged boys arrested in this case and bailed out. His daughter was medically examined. Both the alleged boys are employees of S. Mahender Singh. On 31.05.2007, a quarrel took place between the complainant and S. Mahender Singh and cross cases vide FIR No.348/07 dated 31.05.2007 u/s 323/341/506/34 IPC PS Pahar Ganj against the complainant and FIR No.349/07 dated 31.05.2007 u/s 323/341/354/34 IPC PS Pahar Ganj against S. Mahender Singh, his son etc. were registered. All the above mentioned three cases are pending investigation and no negligence was found on the part of local police. Police has not favoured any party and investigation is being done on merits. The complainant had filed this complaint to pressurize the local police. However, all the accused in both cross cases have already been arrested. The motive/cause of quarrel is to vacate the tenanted premises. The allegations levelled in the complaint could not be substantiated. Keeping in view of above, no action is called for into the matter.
