Please refer to your letter cited under reference (1) above. The matter of
alleged cheating of ST person was enquired into by the ADGP DCRE Bangalore.
The enquiry revealed that the matter is merely an offshoot of financial transaction
between the petitioner Shri.Murali Krishna and the accused Shri.Rafiq Raj and not
of any atrocity on SCs/STs falling under POA Act 1989. Earlier also the same
petition was enquired into by the P.I. Rajajinagar Police Station, Bangalore City
and he has submitted a report to the effect that the accused has vacated his office
and his whereabouts are not known.
