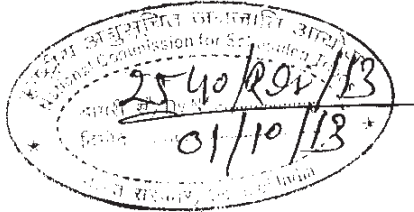

Dear Sir,

The Parliament (Prevention of Disqualification) Act, 1959, as amended from time to time, lists certain offices of profit under the Government of India or the Government of any State, which do not disqualify the holders thereof for being chosen as, or for being, a Member of Parliament.

2. The Joint Committee on Offices of Profit (Fifteenth Lok Sabha), while examining the issue regarding appointment of two Members of Lok Sabha as members in the National Oilseeds and Vegetable Oils Development Board (NOVODB) has suggested for consideration of an amendment in the Parliament (Prevention of Disqualification) Act, 1959, so as to exempt Members of Parliament from incurring disqualification on being appointed to the statutory bodies etc., under the provisions of any law, for the time being in force. Accordingly, this Department provided to the said committee a draft Bill to exempt the office of the Chairman or Chairperson, member or Director of a Board, committee, commission, authority, council or court of a university, body, society, trust (by whatever name called) held by any member of the House of People or the Council of States on being elected or appointed by the House or the Council, as the case may be, to such office constituted or established under any law for the time being in force from incurring disqualification for being a Member of Parliament.

3. The Committee deliberated on the draft Bill provided by the Legislative Department and vide its Eighth Report presented to the Lok Sabha on 4th December, 2012 and laid on the table of Rajya Sabha on the same day has agreed with the draft Bill. A copy of the draft Note for the Cabinet is enclosed herewith.

4. You are, therefore, requested to furnish comments of your Ministry/Department on the proposal contained in the draft Note for the Cabinet at the earliest so as to enable this Department to take further necessary action in the matter.
