NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Subject: Summary record of the meeting of the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes held on 26.03.2008 at 12:00 Noon

A meeting of the Commission was held at 12:00 Noon on 26.03.2008 in the Conference room of the Commission in Lok Nayak Bhawan New Delhi. The meeting presided over by Smt. Urmila Singh, Chairperson, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes was attended by Shri T. Samphel, Hon'ble Member, Shri R.S. Sirohi, Secretary, NCST along with Shri Aditya Mishra, Joint Secretary, Shri Vinod Agarwal, Director, Shri R.C. Durga, Director, Shri R.P. Vasisht, Deputy Secretary, Shri K.N. Singh, Consultant, and Shri S.P. Meena, Asst. Director (Coordination). All items on the Agenda of the meeting were discussed one by one. The following action points emerged out of the discussion.

Agenda Item I: Second Annual Report of the Commission for 2006-07

2. The draft of the Second Annual Report of the Commission for the period 2006-07 was read out by Shri K.N. Singh, Consultant. After discussion of each chapter of the Report at length, suggestions made by Hon'ble Chairperson, Member (TS), Secretary, NCST and other officers of the Commission and the deficiencies/editing required in various chapters were noted.

Agenda Item II Outline of the third Report of the Commission for the year 2007-08

3. The proposal relating to inclusion of the following Chapters relating to development of Scheduled Tribes in the Third report of the Commission were approved:

- (a) Educational development of Scheduled Tribes (in relation to States/UTs which are not covered in the second report of the Commission due to non-availability of record information from them).
- (b) Land alienation laws/regulations enacted by the State Governments (which are not covered in the second report of the Commission due to non-availability of required information from them).
- (c) Measures taken by the State Governments for improving the health conditions and nutrition level of Scheduled Tribes (in relation to States which are not covered in the second report due to non-availability of required information from them).

It was also decided that the draft of these Chapters should be ready by the end of September 2008.

Agenda Item III Thrust areas /Action plan for the fourth report of the Commission for the year 2008-09.

4. The following thrust areas /Action plan for the fourth report of the Commission for the year 2008-09, were approved.

- (i) Efficacy of relief and rehabilitation measures for Scheduled Tribes displaced by major projects.
- (ii) Review of right of Scheduled Tribes and other forest dwellers over forest land including ownership rights in respect of minor forest produce.
- (iii) Problems relating to issuing of Caste Certificates
- (iv) Development of Primitive Tribal Groups (select studies in MP, Manipur, Orissa and Rajasthan).
