Minutes of the Hearing chaired By Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, NCST on 13.06.2024 in the case of A news item captioned "15 year old gang raped at Hyderabad birthday bash", published in the news paper the Times of India, New Delhi dated 09.02.2022. The Commission took Suo Moto Cognizance in this matter.

A news item captioned "15 year old gang raped at Hyderabad birthday bash", published in the news paper the Times of India, New Delhi dated 09.02.2022 received by the Commission. It has been alleged that five men allegedly gang-raped a 15 year old tribal girl after giving her a soft drink mixed with alcohol at a birthday party in Hyderabad's Chatrinaka. After the girl got drunk, the five accused took turns to rape her. The Police stated that they had kept the music loud to ensure that neighbours would not hear any noise in case the girl screamed. Police has registered a case and all the six men were remanded in judicial custody.

2. The Commission took up the matter with the District Collector & District Magistrate, Hyderabad and Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, Telangana vide notice dated 13.03.2023 for ATR/Reply within 03 days.

3. In response to Commission's notice dated 13.03.2023, a report dated 21.03.2023 was received from the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad City, wherein it was reported that Deputy Commissioner of Police, South Zone, Hyderabad inquired the matter and submitted report. On examination of reply dated 21.03.2023 of Deputy Commissioner of Police, South Zone, Hyderabad, the Commission fixed a Hearing on 18.01.2024 with the Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad and Collector & District Magistrate, Hyderabad.

After hearing the matter, the Commission recommended that:

- A socio-economic survey of the victim's family may be conducted along with information about various aspects of their social and economic conditions. While conducting the survey the living standards, financial situation, education, employment, housing and other relevant factors will be given utmost care.
- It is recommended that immediate steps be taken to enroll the girl in school to ensure her access to education and support for her overall development.
- The District Authority, to ensure safety and security of the victim, her family and witnesses. Adequate measures must be taken to ensure their safety and to protect them from any potential harm.
- Request for speedy trial of the case may also be submitted in Hon'ble Court.
- The Commission strongly recommends psycho-social counselling for the victim on top priority
- Action taken report may be submitted by the Commissioner of Police, Telangana and Collector & District Magistrate, Hyderabad, Telangana to the Commission within 30 days.

4. As no reply/ATR received from Commissioner of Police, Telangana and Collector & District Magistrate, Hyderabad, Telangana to the Commission, the Commission fixed another Hearing on 13.06.2024 with the District Collector & District Magistrate, Hyderabad and Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, Telangana.

5. On behalf of the District Collector & District Magistrate, Hyderabad and Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad, Telangana, Tehsildar O/o District Magistrate, Hyderabad, ACP Chatrinaka and SHO Chatrinaka, Hyderabad Police were present. The petitioner was not present as this is a suo moto cognizance case.

6. As responsible authorities didn't appear before the Commission, the hearing was deferred. The Commission decided that next hearing will be held in next 15 days.
