
The National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) set up under Article 338A of the Constitution is vested with responsibility inter-alia, to investigate and monitor all matters relating to the safeguards provided to the Scheduled Tribes under the Constitution or under any other law for the time being in force or under any order of the Government and to monitor and evaluate the working of such safeguards. The Commission is required to present to the President annually and at such other times as the Commission may deem fit, reports upon the working of those safeguards.

2. Accordingly, the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes has decided to visit and review the implementation of constitutional safeguards and development programmes/schemes being run for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes in the District of Vellore (Tamil Nadu) on 1st week of June, 2019. During the review, the Commission will focus implementation of PESA, Forest Rights Act including community forest rights and other issues for which presentation is to be made by District Administration. The tour programme of the visit is being finalized and will be communicated separately.

3. The Commission has evolved a questionnaire for review and a copy of which is enclosed for furnishing replies/information by the District Administration. The questionnaire can also be down loaded from NCST Website <http://ncst.nic.in/content/questionnaire-review-download>. The replies to various issues covered under the questionnaire will form the basis for review meeting in the District. It is requested that the information w.r.t. the questionnaire may please be prepared and furnished to this Commission in hard copy as well as in soft copy to js@ncst.nic.in and dircoord@ncst.nic.in by 30th May, 2019 positively.


