Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi in the case of Dr. Nagendra Hamsavath, Hyderabad, Telangana and others regarding TGPSC Group-1 exams.

A group of Scheduled Tribe (ST) candidates from Telangana, who appeared for the TGPSC Group-1 exams in Telugu medium, have submitted a petition dated 18.03.2025 alleging significant disparity in marks between Telugu and English medium candidates. They state that only five ST candidates are present in the top 100, raising concerns about unfair evaluation. The petitioners request the Commission to direct TGPSC and the Government of Telangana to conduct a re-evaluation of their answer sheets by Telugu medium subject experts and publish the final results accordingly.

2. NCST vide notice dated 21.04.2025 sought facts and comments from the Secretary, Telangana Public Service Commission within 05 days from receipt of the Notice. The reply was not received, hence, decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 09.05.2025. Hence a sitting notice was sent on 29.04.2025.

3. In the sitting, the Secretary, Telangana Public Service Commission (TGPSC) was present. The petitioner joined via phone. The Secretary, TGPSC has informed that the matter is pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana.


4. After discussion with the Secretary, TGPSC and petitioner, it was observed that there is no action warranted on part of NCST, as the matter is subjudice with the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana. Hence, this may be closed.
