Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at LokNayakBhawan, New Delhi in the case of Shri I.ThirupalNaik, Teacher's Colony, Mudigubba regarding redeployment of ST workers.

Shri I. Thirupal Naik, Teacher's Colony, Mudigubba, Shri Stayasai District vide his representation dated 09.09.2024 has stated that he along with other outsourcing workers engaged through manpower agencies served AP Transco during the indefinite strike period starting 22.02.2018 based on assurances from authorities and contractors regarding future redeployment. However, while some individuals have been redeployed as per Memo No SE/OMC/ATP/D.No.2866/2021 dated 28.09.2021 many—particularly those belonging to the ST category—have been left out without any consideration. Alleging partiality and neglect towards ST workers, the petitioner has requested the NCST to intervene and issue favourable orders for their redeployment on par with other workers already absorbed.

- 2. NCST vide notice dated 20.01.2025 sought facts and comments from the CMD, APTRANSCO within 30 days from receipt of the Notice.
- 3. The Chairman and Managing Director, APTRANSCO, vide his letter dated 14.02.2025, has informed that Shri I. Thirupal Naik was temporarily engaged by a contractor during the strike period from 20.02.2018 to 06.03.2018 and was neither recruited nor appointed by APTRANSCO as a regular or contractual employee. It has been clarified that no promises were made by APTRANSCO regarding future appointment and the contractor was solely responsible for such engagement. The petitioner along with others filed W.P. No. 19361/2022 before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh seeking employment based on the strike-period engagement but the petition was dismissed on 23.08.2024. The CMD further stated that only existing security personnel were redeployed by contract agencies based on requirement and no outsourced workers from the strike period were appointed by APTRANSCO. Hence, the petitioner has no right to demand redeployment and the complaint lacks merit. This was forwarded to the petitioner for information on 16.04.2025. However, NCST decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 06.05.2025. Accordingly, a sitting notice was sent on 21.04.2025.
- 4. In the sitting, officers of APTRANSCO were present and the petitioner was also present. The petitioner reiterated his earlier submission and requested for justice. The officers of APTRANSCO have drawn the attention of their reply dated 14.2.2025 and stated that the petitioners application have no merit.

5. After discussion with the officers of APTRANSCO and petitioner, it was observed that there is no action warranted on part of NCST.
