National Commission for Scheduled Tribes

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi in the case of Smt. Isavat Kaili, W/o late Ramulu regarding harassment and rightful claim settlement.

Smt. Isavat Kaili, W/o late Ramulu, resident of Samuthanda village, Venkatayathanda Panchayat, Chandrugonda Mandal, Bhadradri Kothagudem District, Telangana, vide her petition dated 06-03-2025 has stated that her husband, an auto driver, purchased an auto from Kongara TVS showroom through TVS Credit, with an insurance policy under Kotak Mahindra Life Insurance. After her husband's death on 06-09-2024, when she inquired about the death insurance claim, the TVS showroom and EMI collection manager misled and mentally harassed the family by forcing them to pay EMIs with the promise of issuing NOC, which was never given. Later, a third-party agent extorted ₹30,000 from them under false assurances. The petitioner has alleged mental harassment and financial exploitation by the showroom manager, finance manager, insurance manager, and third-party agent, and has requested the Commission's intervention for rightful insurance claim settlement and necessary action against the responsible persons.

- 2. The Commission issued notice to Superintendent of Police, Bhadradari Kothagudem District vide NCST letter dated 25.04.2025 seeking facts and comments within 30 days. No reply has been received by the Commission.
- 3. The Commission decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 18.06.2025. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 10.06.2025.
- 4. In the sitting, DSP, Bhadradri Kothagudem was present on behalf of SP, Bhadradri Kothagudem and the petitioner joined via phone call. The petitioner (ie, the son of Late Ramulu) informed that The EMI Collection Manager called and said him that you have to pay the EMI till the date of receipt of Insurance amount. After receipt of the amount of Insurance benefits, the EMIs will be automatically stopped and the same amount, which was paid by him after death of his father will be returned. On trusting the words of the EMI Manager, they paid EMI amount up to January-2025. As per the agreement the petitioner and deceased both who are barrowers are liable persons.
- 5. The authority informed that the insurance company caused 3rd party enquiry on the death of the deceased. On inquiry they came to know that the deceased Islavath Ramulu has been suffering with disease and getting treatment. So, the deceased violated the insurance norms and self- declaration as Declaration of good health. The Insurance company had given reply to the son of petitioner Islavath Veeru as "It is noticed that about the history of ill health is not disclosed by the member in the DOGH (Declaration of Good Health) and the said nondisclosure amounts to fraud as per Section 45 (2) of the Insurance Act, 1938. Had such information we would not have issued the cover".
- 6. After discussion with the SDPO, Bhadradri Kothagudem and the petitioner, the following recommendations were made and action taken report may be submitted to NCST within 30 days of receipt of minutes.
- Though the authority has advised the petitioner is advised to go to the competent authority i.e., Insurance Regulatory and Development authority to resolve their grievance, as it is uncertain about the timely disposal of the issue, considering the vulnerable status of the petitioner to approach such agencies, the DSP may facilitate and see that the issue is resolved and the petitioner gets a suitable relief.
