NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi in the case of Shri Shrinivasa M, Belathur Colony, Bengaluru regarding injustice by Kadugodi Police Station, Bengaluru.

Shri Shrinivasa M, Belathur Colony, Kadugodi Post, Bengaluru vide his representation dated 30.03.2024 has stated that he has been running a business for several years and had employed a woman named Ramya Bai, who gained his trust and took ₹14 lakhs from him. When the petitioner tried to recover the amount, she issued two cheques which later bounced, leading to cheque bounce cases against her in the ACJM Court, Bengaluru. To escape legal action, Ramya Bai allegedly conspired with one Sandesh Hosamath to file false complaints and threaten the petitioner. The petitioner alleges that both individuals are harassing and intimidating him with false FIRs due to his Dalit identity, causing him mental distress and public humiliation. Despite some of the cases later being closed as false, they continued filing fake complaints, including at Halasuru Gate Police Station, to have him arrested. He has requested the Commission to take action against Ramya Bai and Sandesh Hosamath by registering FIRs, conducting investigations, and ensuring his protection under the law.

2. NCST issued notice to the Commissioner of Police, Bengaluru on 13.02.2025 for seeking facts and comments within 30 days from receipt of the Notice. The reply was not received, hence, NCST, NCST has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 07.08.2025. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 29.07.2025.

3. In the sitting, the ACP, Whitefield Sub- Division, Bengaluru City was present on behalf of Commissioner of Police, Bengaluru and representative of petitioner joined through phone. The representative of the petitioner reiterated the issue and allegations raised by the petitioner in his representation dated 30.3.2024. The ACP, Whitefield Sub- Division, Bengaluru City provided letter no. ACP/WSD/NCST/01/2025 dated 7.8.2025 which contains the facts and comments from the Police Department in the matter. The ACP informed that various complaints have been filed by the petitioner and opponent to the various authorities of the Police Department which has been investigated and closed, as these were baseless. The ACP has also stated that there is mutual misunderstanding between the petitioner and opponents.

4 After discussion with the ACP, Whitefield Sub- Division, Bengaluru City and representative of the petitioner, the following recommendations were made and action taken thereon may be submitted within 30 days from receipt of the minutes.

- The representative of the petitioner is advised to ascertain the community status of the opponent.
- The representative of the petitioner is advised to meet the ACP, Whitefield Sub- Division, Bengaluru City and explain the case in detail.
- The ACP, Whitefield Sub- Division, Bengaluru City is also advised to give an opportunity to the petitioner (His representative) for presenting and explaining the issue of the case.
