NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi in the suo moto cognizance taken by the Commission.

A news clippings where it has been reported that a Scheduled Tribe woman from Sangayiguda Thanda, Medak Mandal, Telangana, was brutally assaulted and sexually abused near a venture close to Padupayal Temple in Kolcharam Mandal. The woman, who worked as a daily wage labourer, was reportedly found tied to a pole with severe head injuries and multiple wounds. She was shifted to Medak District Hospital and later to Gandhi Hospital, where she succumbed to her injuries. Police have stated that samples were sent to the lab for forensic confirmation and that further details will be revealed upon receipt of the report.

- 2. Therefore, NCST took suo moto cognizance and sought facts and comments from the Collector & District Magistrate, District- Medak and Superintendent of Police, District-Medak within 3 days from receipt of the Notice, vide Notice dated 13.10.2025. The reply was not received, hence, NCST decided to discuss the issue with the authorities on 12.11.2025. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 04.11.2025.
- 3. Meanwhile, the Supdt. of Police, District Medak vide letter no. 470/C3/DCRB-MDK/2025 dated 4.11.2025 has furnished the facts and comments and informed that the accused was arrested on 14.10.2025. He was produced before the Hon'ble Court and remanded to judicial custody. The case under further investigation for receipt of the FSL report. Further, It has also been informed that the Hon'ble Addl. District and Sessions Jusde, Medak pronounced judgement in an earlier case i.e. Cr. No. 201/2021, U/s 302, 376, 201 IPC of Medak Town PS wherein the same accused, Megavath Fakeera Nayak was sentenced to life imprisonment and fined Rs. 10,000/-. Hence, the case may be disposed off.
- 4. The District Collector & Magistrate, District Medak vide letter dated 11.11.2025 has sought exemption and deputed District Revenue Officer & Addl. District Magistrate, Medak to attend the sitting. The SP, Medak vide letter dated 7.11.2025 has also deputed DSP, Medak to attend the sitting.
- 5. In the sitting the above officer were present. The District Revenue Officer & Addl. District Magistrate, Medak has provided the letter no. C2/1919/2025 dated 11.11.2025 of Collector District Magistrate, Medak in the sitting. In the letter, the facts and comments and action taken by District Administration has been informed the accused also belongs to ST community. Hence, the PoA Act, could not be enforced.
- 6. After discussion with the above officers of District Administration, Medak, it was observed that since the accused is also ST, hence, no action warranted on part of NCST. However, the District Administration is advised to provide help to the deceased family on humanitarian grounds, as her family belongs to BPL Category. The action taken may be submitted to NCST in 30 days.
 - a. An immediate relief from the funds available under the Tribal Relief fund of Tribal Welfare Department etc may be provided to the family of the deceased so that the children especially the 4 year girl in Anganwadi school is taken care off.
 - b. The Children may be admitted to Ekalavya Model Residential Schools/Tribal Welfare Ashram Schools and monitored so that they wont experience any trauma or stigma.
 - c. A Government Housing scheme under Indiramma may be sanctioned to the family of deceased along with an outsourcing/contract job in any of the Government institutions.
 - d. The police department may enforce strict vigilance and monitoring in and around the toddy shops, liquor shops and other vulnerable zones of potential threat to women.
