Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Schoduled Tribes at Dillustra Circle House Hudershed in the case of Shri Tribes at Dillustra Circle House for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Shri Tejavath Prashanth Naik (Ex-Constable, TGSP) Mahabubabad District regarding harassment and termination from job. Date of the Sitting: 07/11/2025, 04:00 PM

Shri Tejavath Prashanth Naik, (Ex-Constable, TGSP) Mahabubabad District vide his petition dated 25.07.2024 approached NCST regarding a false case registered against him. He states that on 15.08.2023, he was called by the CI of Police, Rajesh (TS-NAB) and instructed to report for an enquiry related to his maternal uncle. Despite being on duty in Kothagudem, he was escorted by police officials to Hyderabad, where he was illegally arrested and detailed by TS NAP. The petitioner alleges that the police officers, including Rajesh and Raghavendra Swamy, falsely implicated him in a case under various sections of the NDPS Act and IPC, even though he was troubles from Mathematical to blood at the time of the alleged incident. He stains that this false are alleged incident. traveling from Kothagudem to Hyderabad at the time of the alleged incident. He claims that this false case led to his job termination without a proper enquiry, causing significant hardship to him and his family. The petitioner requests a thorough investigation into the matter and the actions of the officers involved to ensure justice.

- In this matter, sittings were held on 06.01.2025 and 09.05.2025 and 11.07.2025. In the last sitting held on 2. In this matter, sittings were field on 00.01.2025 and 05.03.2025 and 11.07.2025. In the last sitting field on 1.07.2025, the following recommendations were made and the minutes were sent to all concerned on 07.08.2025 for submission of Action taken report in 30 days.
 - a. The DCP, South West Zone may conclude the enquiry at the earliest.
 - b. The Additional, DGP, TGSP Battalion and ADGP, Greyhounds may furnish a detailed enquiry report on the
 - c. The Additional, DGP, Battalion and ADGP, Greyhounds may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing. grounds on which the petitioner's job is terminated.
 - No reply was received hence the Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 07.11.2025. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 28.10.2025.
 - The petitioner has attended the hearing. The appropriate authorities have not attended the hearing, however deputed the subordinate officials.
 - After hearing to both the petitioner and authority the following recommendations are made and ATR may be submitted in 15 days from the receipt of minutes.
 - a. The ADGP, Greyhounds, Hyderabad, Telangana who relieved the petitioner from duty may explain how the could have been arrested when he was on duty in Kothagudem on the 16th August 2023(As per FIR), a day before as the letter mentions dispatching him to Hyderabad and handing him over to TSNAB on the 17th August 2023 for the purpose of enquiry. Hence actual time line and sequence of events may be indicated.
 - b. The Director, TSNAB, Hyderabad, Telangana may furnish further details on the process followed subsequently after he was handed over.
 - c. The DCP south west zone was earlier directed by NCST to conduct a detailed inquiry on the discrepancy. However no enquiry was done and the report is not submitted to NCST. Hence it is recommended for a detailed enquiry immediately as an innocent ST employee in uniform service has been ruined due to improper verification of documents, without conducting an inquiry.
 - d. The ADGP TGSP battalions may explain as to why the employee is not given an opportunity to defend u. The ADGE 1995 pattallors may explain as to this the High Court order dated 27th himself. Further even after receiving bail on 28th September 2023, with the High Court order dated 27th September 2023, why was termination issued immediately on 29th September 2023.
 - e. As the due process is not followed and proper inquiry is not made, necessary steps may be taken to revoke his termination and to re-instate the employee.
 - f. The ADGP, Greyhounds, ADGP TGSP battalions, DCP south west zone Director, TSNAB, may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing.
