

Minutes of the sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at New Delhi in the case of Smt. Vankudothu Shanthamma, legal heirs of Ajmeera Ramdhan of Suryathanda, Kommula village, Geesugonda Mandal, Warangal District regarding illegal transfer of land.

Smt. Vankudothu Shanthamma, legal heir of Shri Ajmeera Ramdhan, residents of Suryathanda, Kommula Village, Geesugonda Mandal, Warangal District, vide their petition have stated that their father owned 5.27 acres of ancestral assigned land situated in Survey No.165, which remained undivided among the legal heirs. It has been alleged that one of the sisters, without the knowledge or consent of the remaining three sisters, illegally sold a portion of the said land to a person belonging to the Reddy community, on the basis of fake/illegal documents, and that a rice mill has been constructed on the assigned land. The petitioner(s) have further alleged that the illegal sale and construction were carried out with the support of revenue officials and that they are being threatened due to the political influence of the persons involved. Despite submitting repeated representations to the MRO, RDO, Joint Collector, Vice-Chairman, KUDA, and the District Collector, no action has been taken so far. The petitioner(s) have sought restoration of the assigned land, equal division of their father's property among the legal heirs, and action against the officials and private persons involved.

2. NCST issued notice to the District Collector & Magistrate, District-Warangal on 14.11.2025 seeking facts and comments within 30 days from receipt of the Notice. The Reply was not received, it was decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 06.01.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 29.12.2025.

3. In the sitting, the Tehsildar, Geesugonda Mandal was present on behalf of District Collector & Magistrate, District-Warangal and representative of the petitioner were present. The representative of the petitioner has reiterated their earlier submission and requested for justice. The Tehsildar, Geesugonda Mandal has provided the letter bearing no. E1/3292/2025 dated 29.12.2025 of District Collector & Magistrate, District-Warangal which contains the facts and comments on the issue alongwith supporting documents. In the letter, it has been mentioned that the parents of the petitioners stated that their daughters and their Grand Sons are not having any rights upon survey numbers mentioned in the grievance petition and the complaint made is far from truth (a copy of the Statements enclosed with the letter for evidence, which is in Telugu Language). Further reported that, on perusal of the facts, it is clearly established that the present enjoyers of the assigned land in the Sy No. 165 of Kommala(V) are not the actual assignees or their legal heirs and it is clearly establishing that the sale transactions took place upon the assigned land in Sy No. 165 of Kommala Village and it is clear that there is a violation of the assignment rules prescribed in The Telangana Assigned Lands (Prohibition of Transfers) Act, 1977" Hence, the request of the petitioner can not be considered and the action will be initiated in due course against all the enjoyers of Assigned Land in Sy No. 165 of Kommala (v) as per the norms specified in "The Telangana Assigned Lands (Prohibition of Transfers) Act, 1977". The same facts were informed to the petitions through register post bearing No. EN86073598IN.

4. After discussion with the Tehsildar, Geesugonda Mandal and representative of the petitioner, the following recommendations were made and action taken there on may be submitted to NCST within 30 days from receipt of the minutes.

- The District Collector may personally visit the site, cause a detailed enquiry on the disputed survey numbers, alleged mismatch in the NALA and land on which the Rice mill is constructed by Non-Tribals. A detailed report on the boundaries of the patta land and assigned land may be submitted to NCST. The sale deed documents along with the witnesses may be examined.
- The genuinity of original assignees and legal heirs and the petitioners claim may be re-examined afresh.
- If it is noticed that the non tribals have fraudulently obtained any subsidy for plantation purposes, the same may be recovered.
- The petitioner may be provided desired information in a time bound manner as per the provisions of RTI, if any pending documents are sought by the petitioner under RTI.
- After examination of the documents submitted by the District Collector, the NCST advises the Petitioner to re-confirm the genuinity of her claim and maintain integrity before approaching the NCST.
- The original petitioner and District Collector may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing.
