

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at New Delhi in the case of Shri Banoth Srinivas regarding purchase of assigned land.

Shri Banoth Srinivas, vide representation dated 21.08.2023, has stated that he purchased 3 acres of assigned land from A. Janakamma in 2007, unaware of its status. He alleges that Janakamma, belonging to the Reddy community and ineligible for such land, fraudulently obtained the patta and illegally sold it to him. Despite cultivating the land and filing representations with authorities to revoke Janakamma's patta and associated benefits, no action was taken. He asserts that the accused have significant political and financial influence and seeks justice, including the cancellation of the illegal patta and appropriate action against the respondents.

2. In the sitting held on 11.08.2025, the Commission recommended the following and minutes were sent to all concerned vide NCST letter dated 03.09.2025.

- If the "pahanis" were on the name of the petitioner for some duration and as there is an evidence of paying the taxes, the claim of the petitioner may be considered.
- The BPL status of the Ramavath Naji Dependant of Shri. B. Srinivas may be confirmed and assignment may be made in the name of his widowed sister Smt. Ramavath Naji who has withdrawn her WP in the Hon'ble High court of Telangana as it is not a sub-judice.

3. The Action taken report was not received, hence, it was decided to discuss the matter with the authority and petitioner on 05.01.2026. Accordingly, a sitting notice was issued on 26.12.2025. In the sitting, the Collector and Magistrate, District – Suryapet was present and petitioner joined through online.


4. The District Collector has submitted that the Government of Telangana has introduced the BhuBharati Act, 2025. In accordance with the provisions of the said Act, Revenue Sadassulu have been conducted and applications are being received for fresh assignments. In this process, Smt. Ramavath Naji has also submitted her application. At present, the guidelines relating to the constitution and functioning of the Assignment Committee are awaited from the Government. Hence after receipt of the said guidelines, the request of Smt. Ramavath Naji for assignment of land shall be positively and duly considered in accordance with the rules and procedures in force.

5. After discussion with the Collector and Magistrate, District – Suryapet and petitioner, the following recommendations were made and action taken report may be submitted to NCST within 30 days from receipt of the minutes.

- a. As the name of Smt. Janakamma was deleted from the Revenue Records in Sy.No.71/112, the Revenue Department may reclaim the said land immediately to its custody without further delay.
- b. The request of Smt. Ramavath Naji for assignment of land may be considered in accordance with the rules and procedures in force.
