

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Nenavath Janamma and other affected ST cultivators of Veerlapalem Village regarding takeover of their land by TSGENCO without due compensation.

The petitioner(s), Nenavath Janamma and other affected ST cultivators of Veerlapalem Village, Damarcherla Mandal, Nalgonda District, vide their representation dated (date not mentioned), have submitted that they belong to the Scheduled Tribe community and have been in peaceful possession and cultivation of agricultural lands in Forest Block No. 42 and Survey No. 129 of Veerlapalem Village for more than 45 years, since the time of their forefathers, and their livelihood solely depends on the said lands. It is alleged that around Ac. 80.34 guntas (approximately 32.34 hectares) of their lands were forcibly taken by Telangana State Power Generation Corporation Limited (TSGENCO) for the Yadadri Thermal Power Plant Project without following due process of law, without issuance of any land acquisition notification and without payment of compensation under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013. The petitioners have further stated that they are forest land cultivators eligible under the Forest Rights Act, 2006, but their RoFR claims were wrongly rejected despite confirmation of cultivation by forest officials, as evidenced from reports of the Forest Range Officer, Miryalguda vide Rc.No.194/2016 dated 13.07.2016, Letter Rc.No.2037/2016 dated 21.06.2016, and joint inspection reports. It is also stated that the petitioners approached the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in WP No. 13557 of 2018, wherein a show cause notice was issued to the State for illegally taking their lands, however, till date no compensation has been paid, resulting in displacement, loss of livelihood and severe hardship to the affected ST families.

2. The Commission issued notice to the District Collector, District:-Nalgonda vide NCST letter dated 12.11.2025 seeking facts and comments within 30 days.

3. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 28.01.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 22.01.2026.

4. The petitioner has attended the hearing. On behalf of the TGGENCO, The Director, Civil and CE, GENCO have attended the hearing.

5. The petitioner has reiterated the grievance and have furnished the Patta pass books, Bank statements and the report of FRO, Miryalguda in support of their claim. Further mentioned the Hon'ble High Court Orders where in the respondents were directed not to raise any compound wall in veerapalem village of Damaracharla mandal of Nalgonda District situated in Sy.No.42 and Sy.No.129. Out of 70 PDF Families, only 13 were accepted by the authorities.

6. The authorities have stated that an extent of Ac.225.15 Gts of ROFR land was only acquired by registering the lands from ROFR Patta holders vide GO.Ms.No.123 Dated 30.07.2015 and the petitioners land has not come under the alignment, thus theirs land has not got registered and not compensated. It is further informed that the Forest Department was paid compensation and and certain amount is lying with the District Administration and it is the discretion of District Administration to finalise and compensate the PDFs.

7. After hearing to the petitioner and authority, the following observations/recommendations were made and the ATR may be submitted to NCST in 30 days.

a. The details of the land acquired for the YTPS along with the breakup (Revenue land, Assigned, D-Form, ROFR etc) along with the survey numbers and the affected families may be submitted to NCST.

b. The total number of PDFs who were given compensation and provided employment under the LARR Act, 2013 may be furnished.

c. A detailed Joint survey by the Forest and Revenue Departments may be conducted to ascertain the veracity of the claim and reconcile the forest revenue boundaries.


d. The District Collector, District Forest Officer and TGGENCO/YTPS may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing.

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

