Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Shri Bhookya Ram Reddy, IPS., Dy. Commissioner of Police, Peddapally regarding reduction of pay upon promotion to IPS.

Shri Bhookya Ram Reddy, IPS., Dy. Commissioner of Police, Peddapally (formerly Superintendent of Police, CID, Hyderabad), vide his representation dated 05.01.2026 has stated that after his promotion from State Police Service to IPS cadre, his basic pay was reduced from Rs.1,65,760/- to Rs.1,30,100/- w.e.f. 22.08.2024, and he was directed to remit Rs.4,16,650/- vide Memo dated 08.12.2025, despite relying on the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment dated 21.10.2009 which held that pay should not be reduced after induction into IPS. He further stated that his representations dated 24.09.2025 and 28.10.2025 were not properly considered and the State Government's action amounts to harassment of an ST officer nearing retirement in April 2027. He has requested the Commission to direct the Government of Telangana to restore his basic pay and refund the recovered amount.

2. NCST vide notice dated 07.01.2026 sought facts and comments from Chief Secretary, General Administration Department, Telangana, Principal Secretary, Home Department, Government of Telangana and The Pay and Accounts Officer, Hyderabad within 15 days.

3. The Pay and Accounts Officer, Hyderabad vide his letter dated 31.01.2026 has informed the Commission that Shri B. Ram Reddy, IPS (SPS), DCP, Peddapally was promoted to IPS cadre w.e.f. 21.08.2024, and his pay was fixed as per Rule-5(3) of IPS (Pay) Rules, 2016 based on last pay drawn in State Police Service which was revised to Rs.1,58,380/- after notional seniority fixation. Accordingly, his IPS pay was fixed at Rs.1,26,300/- w.e.f. 22.08.2024 and refixed at Rs.1,30,100/- w.e.f. 01.05.2025, following standard procedure applied to all SPS officers promoted to IPS. It was further stated that the officer's claim of last pay Rs.1,65,760/- is factually incorrect and the Supreme Court judgment cited by him is not applicable, as the pay fixation was done as per IPS (Pay) Rules, 2016 under 7th CPC norms. This was sent to the petitioner vide NCST letter dated 04.02.2026.

4. The Chief Secretary to Government, General Administration (Spl.B) Department, Government of Telangana vide his letter dated 07.02.2026 has informed the Commission that the representation dated 24.09.2025 submitted by Shri B. Ram Reddy, IPS, Superintendent of Police, CID, Telangana seeking restoration of his basic pay of Rs.1,65,760/- and refund of Rs.89,004/- has been examined and disposed of, as his pay was fixed as per IPS (Pay) Rules, 2016 following promotion to IPS cadre w.e.f. 21.08.2024. It was stated that after notional seniority revision his last pay in State Police Service was Rs.1,58,380/- and his IPS pay was accordingly fixed at Rs.1,30,100/- under Level-11, which is the standard procedure applied to all similarly promoted officers, and the provisions of IPS (Pay) Rules, 1954 or cited judgments are not applicable. Hence, the request for restoration of pay was found devoid of merit and rejected.

5. The petitioner vide his rejoinder dated 16.02.2026 has stated that after his promotion to IPS cadre w.e.f. 21.08.2024, his basic pay was reduced from Rs.1,65,760/- to Rs.1,30,100/- citing IPS (Pay) Rules, 2016, which he claims is legally unsustainable and contrary to the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment dated 21.10.2009 in Union of India vs. T.M. Somarajan & Others. He further submitted that he was directed to remit Rs.4,16,650/- vide Memo dated 08.12.2025, was not paid salary for December 2025 and January 2026, and his earlier representations dated 24.09.2025, 28.10.2025 and 05.01.2026 were not properly considered. alleging harassment of an ST officer nearing retirement, he has again requested the Commission to direct the Government of Telangana to restore his basic pay and refund the recovered amount.

6. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 06.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 27.02.2026.

7. The petitioner has attended the hearing. The authorities are represented by Joint PAO, Asst. Secretary, GAD. The petitioner has reiterated his grievance that he is facing hardships as his salary is stopped and is not paid for the last 3 months. Despite the existing Government Memos and established Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgements in order dated 21.10.2009 vide Civil Appeal No. 9041 of 2003 with SLP(C) Nos. 14700-14701/2004 and SLP(C) No. 8967 of 2007 between Union of India Vs T.M. Somarajan & Others. It is further represented that it is causing more humiliation and trauma as his juniors as Non-cadre SsP are drawing more basic pay and salaries than him.

8. The authorities have stated that the his pay was fixed as per Rule-5(3) of IPS (Pay) Rules, 2016 based on last pay drawn in State Police Service which was revised to Rs.1,58,380/- after notional seniority fixation.

9. After hearing to the petitioner and authorities, the following observations/ recommendations are made and ATR may be submitted in 15 days from the receipt of Minutes.



a. In the light of Memo No. 50/Spl.B/A3/2015 dated 09.05.2020 issued by the Government of Telangana, General Administration.(SPL.B) Department, which states that the authorization to draw pay and allowances in respect of IPS and IFS officers working in the State of Telangana shall not be stopped and shall continue without any interruption, the matter may be examined.

b. The Chief Secretary to the Government of Telangana may take up the matter with the Advocate General for the State of Telangana regarding the applicability of the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment in this case and may also approach DoPT for clarification immediately so that further necessary action may be taken.
