Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Shri Tejavath Prashanth Naik (Ex-Constable, TGSP) Mahabubabad District regarding harassment and termination from job.


Shri Tejavath Prashanth Naik, (Ex-Constable, TGSP) Mahabubabad District vide his petition dated 25.07.2024 represented regarding a false case registered against him. He states that on 15.08.2023, he was called by the CI of Police, Rajesh (TS-NAB) and instructed to report for an enquiry related to his maternal uncle. Despite being on duty in Kothagudem, he was escorted by police officials to Hyderabad, where he was illegally arrested and detained by TS-NAB. The petitioner alleges that the police officers, including Rajesh and Raghavendra Swamy, falsely implicated him in a case under various sections of the NDPS Act and IPC, even though he was traveling from Kothagudem to Hyderabad at the time of the alleged incident. He claims that this false case led to his job termination without a proper enquiry, causing significant hardship to him and his family. The petitioner requests a thorough investigation into the matter and the actions of the officers involved to ensure justice.

2. In this matter, sittings were held on 06.01.2025 and 09.05.2025, 11.07.2025 and 07.11.2025. In the sitting held on 11.07.2025, the following recommendations were made –

- a. The DCP, South Zone may conclude the enquiry at the earliest.
- b. The Additional, DGP, Battalion and ADGP, Greyhounds may furnish a detailed enquiry report on the grounds on which the petitioners job is terminated.
- c. The Additional, DGP, Battalion and ADGP, Greyhounds may attend to the next scheuled date of hearing.

3. In the sitting held on 07.11.2025, the following recommendations were made –

- a. The ADGP, Greyhounds, Hyderabad, Telangana who relieved the petitioner from duty may explain how he could have been arrested when he was on duty in Kothagudem on the 16th August 2023(As per FIR), a day before as the letter mentions dispatching him to Hyderabad and handing him over to TSNAB on the 17th August 2023 for the purpose of enquiry. Hence actual time line and sequence of events may be indicated.
- b. The Director, TSNAB, Hyderabad, Telangana may furnish further details on the process followed subsequently after he was handed over.
- c. The DCP south west zone was earlier directed by NCST to conduct a detailed inquiry on the discrepancy. However no enquiry was done and the report is not submitted to NCST. Hence it is recommended for a detailed enquiry immediately as an innocent ST employee in uniform service has been ruined due to improper verification of documents, without conducting an inquiry.
- d. The ADGP TGSP battalions may explain as to why the employee is not given an opportunity to defend himself. Further even after receiving bail on 28th September 2023, with the High Court order dated 27th September 2023, why was termination issued immediately on 29th September 2023.
- e. As the due process is not followed and proper inquiry is not made, necessary steps may be taken to revoke his termination and to re-instate the employee.
- f. The ADGP, Greyhounds,ADGP TGSP battalions,DCP south west zone ,Director, TSNAB, may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing."




4. Addl. Director General of Police, Telangana Special Police vide his letter dated 20-12-2025 has informed the Commission that the petitioner was arrested on 17-08-2023 in Crime No. 248/2023 under NDPS Act and IPC sections while on deputation at Greyhounds and was repatriated to his parent unit on 18-08-2023, after which preliminary enquiry was conducted and his probation was terminated on 29-09-2023 under Rule 17(a)(ii) of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 with one month pay in lieu of notice. It was further stated that probation termination does not require formal disciplinary enquiry, there is no appeal provision against such termination, his representation was disposed on 15-06-2024, and he has filed Writ Petition No. 26190/2024 before the Hon'ble High Court, which is presently sub judice.
5. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 05.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 24.02.2026.
6. The petitioner has attended the hearing. The authority is represented by Sq.Commander, Grey Hounds, Commandant, and DSP Eagle Force, Telangana.
7. The petitioner has reiterated his grievance that he has facing severe financial crisis and his family is undergoing social ostracism for the mistake he has not committed.
8. The authority ie, Addl DGP, Operations (Grey Hounds & Octopus) has time line and sequence of events relating to alleged involvement of Sri.T.Prashanth Naik, PC-1146/JC-4914 of Grey Hounds, Telangana in NPDS Act case. It is mentioned that the petitioner has reported in Grey hounds on 26.7.21 FN on deputation basis and he was posted in Active Unit(TG-7) for anti-extremist duties. He was apprehended by Telangana State Anti Narcotic Bureau police while he was at Greyhounds base camp, Kothagudem, Bhadradi Kothagudem District on 16.8.23 for his alleged involvement in interstate Ganja Smuggling case. On 17.8.23 a report was received from DAC,TG-07 A/Unit , Greyhounds, Telangana about the arrest of Shri. T. Prashanth Naik by Telangana Anti Narcotic Bureau and accordingly an order was issued on 18.8.23 repatriating him to his parent unit. ie, 4th BN, TGSP, Mamnoor lines, warangal w.e.f 17.8.2023 FN under deemed provision.
9. After hearing to the petitioner and authority the following observations/recommendations are made by the commission.
- a. There were procedural lapses in the enquiry process and terminating him from the job. The petitioner and his vehicle were brought to Hyderabad and there he was implicated and arrested falsely.
- b. The issue is being heard by NCST since last 15 months in multiple hearings without any progress.
- c. Hence the Special Chief Secretary, Home Department, DGP, Telangana and CP, Hyderabad may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing on 23.3.2026.
