Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Shri Islawat Rajender, R/o Kotra Thanda, Veldanda Mandal, Nagarkurnool District regarding encroachment of ST land.

Shri Islawat Rajender, R/o Kotra Thanda, Veldanda Mandal, Nagarkurnool District, Telangana, vide his petition/rejoinder dated 01-09-2025 has alleged that after purchasing agricultural land in Survey No. 354 on 19-09-2023, the previous landowners namely Kannaya Yadav, Smt. Sangeetha and Shweta Yadav along with hired bouncers illegally encroached upon the land, assaulted and threatened him, and abused him in the name of his ST community. He has further stated that despite approaching the MRO, RI, CI and SI, no action was taken and the officials acted in favour of the accused persons. He has requested the Commission to ensure restoration of his land, take strict action against the accused and provide protection to him and his family.

2. NCST vide notice dated 19.09.2025 sought facts and comments from the District Collector & Mangistrate, District:- Nagarkurnool and Superintendent of Police, District:- Nagarkurnool within 30 days.

3. The District Collector & District Magistrate, Nagarkurnool vide his letter dated 02.12.2025 has informed the Commission that the representation of Shri Islawat Rajender alleging encroachment and threats regarding land in Sy.No.354 at Veldanda Village was examined through reports of the RDO and Tahsildar, which revealed that the land is patta land recorded in the names of various pattadars and has undergone multiple registered sale transactions over the years. It was further reported that the petitioner has filed O.S. No.40 of 2024 before the Hon'ble Junior Civil Judge, Kalwakurthy, and the matter is sub-judice, and necessary action will be taken after the final court order.

4. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 05.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 24.02.2026.

5. The pettiioner has attended the hearing. The Authority ie, District Collector was represented by the Additional Collector, Revenue, Nagarkurnool and RDO, Kalwakurthy. The Authority from Police Department side is represented by Dy.S.P Kalwakurthy.

6. The petitioner has reiterated his grievance. The authorities have informed that the land of Ac 0.35 Gts remain in the name of Md. Fazal which was actually deducted for road extention but due to technical error the land continued in the name of Md. Fazal. Later the same land is purchased by petitioner and tried to take posession of said land but the respondent stopped him.

7. The petitioner informed that he has actually purchased the said land through a registered document and the same is ialso recorded in Dharani portal. They are in actual posession till the last 6 months and is raising horsegram(Uluvalu) in the said patch of land and though the previous MRO and RDO gave the report that the land is in the name of the petitioner , the current MRO gave a report that it was demarcated for Road for widening of the Srisailam Highway. It is further informed that the assigned land of SCs is also encroached by Shri Kannaya Yadav's family and are posessing excess land than the extent found online on their name.

8. After hearing to the petitioner and authority the following observations/recommendations are made and the ATR may be submitted in 15 days from the receipt of the Minutes.

a. As there are allegations of encroachment, entire Ac.14.39 Gts in survey No.354 may be surveyed and Gram sabha may be conducted to ascertain the facts in the field.

b. As there is no NOC taken and no compensation given to Shri Kannaya Yadav for the alienation of 0.35 Gts for the NH road, it may not be appropriate to conclude that he is the owner of that land and he is in possession of it. The Revenue authorities and RO NH may explain the reasons of alienation without compensation to the said land. It may also be clarified how an innocent ST is made to suffer for the mistake made by the revenue authorities.



c. The Police Department may explain why the case is filed on the petitioner rather than an atrocity case against the opponent who have threatened the petitioner. Protection may be given to the petitioner against alleged threatenings.

d. The District Collector, Superintendent of Police, AD Survey settlements and Land records, RO, NHAI-Hyderabad may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing.
