Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Mukara Ramatulasamma regarding attack by non ST members.

The petitioner, Shri Angoth Krishna, S/o Mangya, resident of Dhannasari village, Kesamudram Mandal, Mahabubabad District, along with 47 poor families belonging to SC, ST and BC communities, vide their representation dated 03-10-2025, has stated that they have been cultivating about 92 acres of Government land in Survey No. 285/1 (also mentioned as Survey No. 235/1) of Dhannasari Revenue Village for the last 30-80 years and are fully dependent on agriculture for their livelihood. It is alleged that the Forest authorities are obstructing their possession by claiming the land as Reserved Forest, without furnishing any certified records, Gazette notifications under Section (15), or proof of declaration under Section (4)/(41) showing when and how the land was notified as Reserved Forest. The petitioner has further contended that as per 1956-57 and 1957-58 pahani records, about 784 acres in the said survey is recorded as Government land, and the Forest officials are misleading the families and forcing them to repeatedly visit offices, causing financial loss and hardship. The petitioner has requested intervention of the Commission for demarcation of the land and issuance of pattadar passbooks, stating that despite prolonged efforts, no justice has been rendered so far.

2. The Commission issued notice to the Collector & District Magistrate,, District- Mahabubabad and District Forest Officer District- Mahabubabad vide NCST letter dated 24.10.2025 seeking facts and comments within 30 days.

3. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 05.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 24.02.2026.

4. The petitioner has attended the hearing. The District Collector is represented by the Tahsildar.

5. The petitioner has reiterated his grievance that due to unclear demarcation of the Forest and Revenue boundaries, their rights were not being taken into consideration.

6. The District Collector vide Lr.Rc.No.REV/E2/408/0075/2025 Dated 4.3.26 has stated that as per the filled report in Sy.No.235 of Dhannasari village, it has a total extent of Ac.755.03 Gts as per the Forest Gazette, out of which Ac.735.03 Gts has been notified as Reserve forest and remaining Ac.20.00 Gts alone is classified as Revenue land . Further based on the Tahsildars enquiry report the following are submitted.

a. As per the Revenue records ie, Khasra Pahani and subsequent pahanies, the SY.No.235 is classified as Government land.

b. The land claimed by the petitioner falls entirely with in Sy.No.235 which is recorded as Forest land as per the Forest Gazette.

c. During the joint inspection conducted by the Mandl surveyor, Mandal Girdhawar and Forest officials, it was clearly observed and confirmed that the land shown by the petitioner is under the possession and control of the Forest Department and is covered with Forest Department Eucalyptus plnatations.

d. The petitioner has never been in possession of the land and has never cultivated the land and has never raised any crops at any point of time.

e. There are no assignment orders/pattas/pahani entries/revenue records in the name of the petitioner relating to the claimed land.

7. The authority ie, Tahsildar present during the hearing submitted that though the Gramsabha was conducted and the petitioner is unable to show the exact patch of Ac.3.00 of land under cultivation and has vaguely shown a land of extent Ac.82.00 which is under possession and control of Forest Department. it is further stated that a detailed enquiry was done when a case was filed before simialr matter in Hon'ble High Court of Telangana in 2016.

8. After hearing to both the petitioner and authority, the following observations/recommendations are made and the ATR may be submitted in 30 days from the receipt of minutes.

- a. The Revenue and Forest land in the said survey No of 235 may be demarcated.
- b. cartosat maps of the said survey Number prior to the cut off date of FRA in 2005 may be furnished to NCST.
- c. Field visit may be planned by NCST after the receipt of the report from District Collector and DFO.
