Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Shri Bhattu Nagesh regarding Record of Rights issued to other non tribal on his land.

Shri Bhattu Nagesh, H.No.1-5-193, Yellandu, No.2 Basthi, Bhadradri Kothagudem-507123 has represented that their land is been issued Record of Rights on some other non-tribal names by the revenue authorities when the case pertaining to Land Transfer Regulation in Scheduled area is pending.

2. The Commission issued notice to the Collector & District Magistrate, District-Bhadradri Kothagudem and the Project Officer, Integrated Tribal Development Agency(ITDA), District- Bhadradri Kothagudem vide NCST letter dated 10.10.2025 seeking facts and comments within 30 days.
3. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 05.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 27.02.2026.
4. The petitioner has attended for the hearing. The authority ie, the District Collector is represented by the Revenue Divisional Officer.
5. The petitioner has reiterated the grievance. It is stated that the fake documents were created tampering the pahani records and changing the survey numbers to issue the patta in the name of Mandala Veeraiah S/o Mandala Saidhulu. The petitioner claimed that the very village is initially created by his forefathers and his forefathers are buried on the same land and questioned how is it possible to bury them on the said land if it is not owned bythem in the past. He further stated that the panchanama which the revenue authorities claimed to have conducted is without his presence. The petitioner has stated that the non tribal Mandala Saidhulu has come only in 1980's from Thirumalayapalem and his ancestors were never there in the said location.
6. The authority has submitted that the petitioner Shri Battu Nagesh S/o Chanda is not in possession of the land in the survey numbers of 651/3, 653/2, 654/4 and 655/3. As per the authorities the Mandala Veeriaah did not purchase the land from Battu Pulya, Grand father of the petitioner or from any of his legal heirs but it has directly been an ancestral property of Mandal veeriaah as his father has purchased the same form Shaik Sharif in 1965 and after his death it is inherited by him. It is further stated that as per tghe provisions of LTR, the applicability of LTR will only come into picture if a transfer is made in contravention to the provisions of the regulation and as per the revenue pahanies entries of survey numbers under appeal, tehre is no proof of ttransfer.
7. After hearing to the petitioner and authority, the following observations/Recommendations are made and the ATR may be submitted in 30 days from the receipt of Minutes.
  - a. The detailed report submitted by the authority may be shared to the petitioner for the submission of the rejoinder if any.
  - b. When the LTR Case is pending since 2011 why was it delayed to decide the case.
  - c. District Collector may cause a detailed enquiry/survey by the District Surveyor.
  - d. Panchanama may be made in presence of the petitioner to ascertain the facts.
