NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad negligence by the Government of Karnataka in providing security to Shri S.H. Subhash, State President, Karnataka State Tribals Hitharakshana Sangha, Mysuru.

The petitioner, Shri S.H. Subhash, State President, Karnataka State Tribals Hitharakshana Sangha, Mysuru, vide his representation dated 04.09.2025 has stated that despite multiple complaints regarding life threats from individuals who allegedly obtained fake ST caste certificates, the Government of Karnataka, including senior police authorities such as the ADGP, State Intelligence, has withdrawn the protection earlier provided to him and his family without notice. He submits that he has repeatedly approached the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Hon'ble President, Hon'ble Home Minister, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Chief Secretary Karnataka, DG & IGP Karnataka, and the NCST, but no effective action has been taken. The petitioner alleges continuous negligence by State authorities despite directions from various constitutional offices, and seeks immediate restoration of security including a gunman, reliever, and residential guard at his new address in Mysuru.

2. In the sitting held on 17.12.2025, the petitioner was present while the authority was not present. After discussion with the petitioner, the following recommendations were made.

- The petitioner is advised to submit name of the candidate (his/ her native place, present postal address), who obtained fake ST certificate to the NCST, as discussed in the sitting. After receipt of the detail, the matter will be taken up with the concerned authority.
- The DGP, Govt. of Karnataka is advised to consider the request of the petitioner for providing security in view of threat to his life considering the sensitiveness of the issue."

3. As no action taken report is received, the Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 06.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 27.02.2026.

4. The petitioner has attended the hearing. The ACP, Krishnaraja sub division, Mysuru city has attended the hearing on behalf of the authority.

5. The petitioner has reiterated his grievance. It is Stated that though the SP, Mysuru has acknowledged the threat the ADGP, Intelligence is denying to provide the security. Currently he is staying in the isolated location in outskirts and is prone to the alleged threats as several of the alleged fraudulent caste certificate holders are staying in the same vicinity. There is no reliever to the residential guard provided to him making it difficult for him to secure himself from current threat circumstances.

6. The authority has submitted Lr.No.COP/GB-1/NCST/2026 Dated 17.2.26 where in it is stated that it is observed that there are no recorded instances of recent threat calls nor has the petitioner filed any formal police complaints against specific individuals regarding threats. Furthermore no recent complaints have been filed by him at the Directorate of Civil Rights Enforcement (DCRE)., Mysuru unit against individuals obtaining government benefits through fraudulent caste certificates. It s further submitted that several communities against whom the petitioner alleged as false caste certificates have been recently officially included in the ST list as per the orders of Government of Karnataka.It is stated that as the petitioner has recently relocated his residence from Mysuru city limits to No.1373, Hanchya, Sathagalli "A" Zone, Mysuru which falls under the jurisdiction of SP Mysuru District rather than the Mysuru city police jurisdiction, based on the current threat asesment, there is no requirement of additional security measures.

7. The Superintendent of Police, Mysuru District vide Letter No.GB(1)/NCSC/15/2025 Dated 05.03.2026 enclosed d an enquiry report made by Police inspector, Mysore South Police Station where in it is mentioned that at the time of inspection of his house it is found that there is a requirement of residential guard and one more gunnment for his protectionand recommended the same.

8. After hearing to the petitioner and authorities the following observations/recommendations are made.

- a. DGP, Karnataka and ADGP, State intelligence may examine the issue and consider providing the petitioner necessary security immediately.
- b. ADGP, State intelligence may provide necessary information to the petitioner on his RTI application.
- c. The DGP, Karnataka and ADGP, State intelligence may attend to the next scheduled date of hearing with a detailed report.
