

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES

Minutes of the Sitting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes at Dilkusha Guest House, Hyderabad in the case of Shri C. Parvathalu, Conductor, Mehdipatnam Depot, TGSRTC regarding removal from service.

The petitioner, Shri C. Parvathalu, Conductor, Mehdipatnam Depot, TGSRTC Telangana, vide his petition dated 19-08-2025 has stated that he was suspended from duty after TTIs booked a case against him when his ticketing machine stopped working during service on 20-11-2023, due to which 5 passengers could not be issued tickets immediately. He alleged that despite informing the controller and mechanic and handing over the machine, he was forced to sign a memo and later issued a charge sheet and suspension, and though suspension was revoked on 17-07-2024, his appeals before Deputy RM, RM and ED were rejected. He requested the Commission for justice and reinstatement, citing financial hardship and family medical problems.

2. The Commission issued notice to the Vice Chairman & Managing Director, Telangana State Road Transport Corporation TGSRTC vide NCST letter dated 19.09.2025 seeking facts and comments within 30 days.

3. The Vice Chairman & Managing Director, Telangana State Road Transport Corporation vide his letter dated 17.10.2025 has informed the Commission that Shri C. Parvathalu, Ex-Conductor of Mehdipatnam Depot, was removed from service on 17.05.2024 after he was found guilty in an enquiry for serious cash and ticket irregularities committed on 20.11.2023, where he collected fares from passengers but issued white papers instead of valid tickets. A charge sheet was issued on 06.12.2023, enquiry findings were communicated on 16.04.2024, and after considering his replies, a show-cause notice dated 03.05.2024 was issued and the removal order passed. The petitioner's appeals, review and mercy petitions were rejected on 25.07.2024, 01.11.2024 and 28.11.2024 respectively. It was further stated that he had earlier irregularities and had once been removed on 10.06.2011 in a similar case but reinstated through Labour Court; hence, due to repeated misconduct, his removal was upheld as per TGSRTC regulations.

4. The Commission has decided to discuss the issue with the authority and the petitioner on 05.03.2026. Accordingly, a Sitting Notice was sent on 25.02.2026.

5. The petitioner has attended the hearing. The VC&MD, TGRTC and Chief Personnel Manager, Bus Bhavan have attended the hearing.

6. The petitioner has reiterated his grievance and he has informed that the he has several time tried to contact the help centre to rectify the technical slags in the Ticket issuing machine and further the vehicle he was driving is a hired vehicle and has a heavy passenger load,he could not halt it. Though the witness statements are in his favour, he was punished.

7. The authorities have stated that upon examination it is found that the TIM Machine is working properly and as the witness statements taken on spot and through whatsapp varied, it is suspected that the witness statements he obtained are improper.

8. After hearing to the petitioner and authority the following recommendations are made and ATR may be submitted in 60 days from the receipt of the Minutes.

a. The case is issue relating to the employees operating in high stress environments of urban traffic and heavy passenger loads in peak timings on road. Hence, may be considered on humanitarian grounds and his mercy petition may be placed before the next upcoming board meeting for consider for reinstatement with minor punishment.

b. The employees ie, conductors and drivers may be trained on standard operating protocol and guidelines in the event of technical slags of the machinery.

c. However, necessary steps may be taken to train ST employees to work with due diligence and discipline to avoid any such mishappenings in future.
