Minutes of Meeting held on 12.02.2024 Chaired By Shri Ananta Nayak, Hon'ble Vice-Chairperson (Acting), National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) in the case of Smt. Banothu Lakshmi, Khammam District regarding trying to disposes and occupy her land in Karepallii Mandal Khammam District and threatening forcibly to lever her land by non STs

Date of Meeting: 12.02.2024 List of Participants is Annexed.

The Commission has received a representation dated 06.11.2023 from Smt. Banothu Lakshmi, Khammam District regarding an attempt to disposes and occupy her land in Karepallli Mandal Khammam District and threatening forcibly by a non-STs. She alleged that her mother Banoth Bujji was the obsolute owner and possessor of an agriculture land to an extent Ac. 10.00 Guntas in Sy. No. 548/37/5 is situated at Usirikayalapally Village, Kerapalli, Khammam District towards the petitioner was executed a registered Gift deed in favour of her in the year 2021 and since then she became absolute owner and peaceful possessor of the said land and got issued with a pattadar passbook vide No. T26160032831. She alleged that on 24.09.2023 the accused persons came to the land and tried to interfere with her activity with her mother and used filthy languages.

- 2. The Commission took up this matter with the Director General of Police, Telangana and Commissioner of Police, Khammam on 22.12.2023.
- 3. In response to NCST Notice dated 22.12.2023, the Commissioner of Police, Khammam vide its report dated 19.01.2024 reported that a case in Cr. No. 216/2023 U/s 294(b) IPC & Sec 3(1)(r)(s) of SCs & STs (PoA) Act, 1989 Amendment Act, 2015 has been registered at Karepalli Police Station on the complaint of the petitioner which is being investigated by Asst. Commissioner of Police, Khammam Rural Division and it will be finalized as per merits of investigation.
- 4. On examination of action taken report of the Commissioner of Police, Khammam, the Commission fixed a Meeting on 12.02.2024 with the Commissioner of Police, Khammam.
- 5. On behalf of the Commissioner of Police, Khammam, the ACP, Khammam appeared before the Commission. The petitioner was not present in the Meeting. She had given authorization letter on 11.02.2024 for allowing her husband to attend the Meeting. The petitioner's husband (Shri Shankar) was also present in the Meeting.
- 6. The matter was discussed in detail. The petitioner's husband submitted before the Commission that the opponent is continuously harassing them by way of stopping the passage/road, creates problem in supplying of drinking water and disconnect electricity.
- 7. The ACP Khammam submitted before the Commission that the investigation was entrusted to the Asst. Commissioner of Police, Khammam Rural Division vide proceedings in C. No. 101/C1/CCRB/SC-ST/Pro/2023 dated 27.12.2023 of Police, Khammam and the investigation is in progress for further examination of witnesses. Based on the statement of witness and the collected evidence the case will be finalized as per the findings of the investigation.

 ACP, Khammam to submit updated status report of the case to the Commission within 07 days.

 It may be ensured that the opponents do not block the road and create problem in supplying of drinking water and electricity to petitioner and his family.

Charge sheet may be submitted in the concerned Courts within stipulated time (16 days) under the provision of SC/ST (PoA) Act, 1989.

Monetary compensation as provided under the SC/ST (PoA) Rules may be provided by the District Administration to the victim expediously.

 On completion of the above Action Taken Report may again be submitted to the Commission.
