The National Commission for Scheduled Tribes (NCST) is a constitutional body set up under Article 338A of the Constitution of India to investigate and monitor all matter relating to protection, welfare and socio-economic development of Scheduled Tribes in the country. As per constitutional provisions, the Union and every State Govt. shall consult the Commission on all major policy of decisions affecting Scheduled Tribes. The Commission is required to present to the Hon'ble President of India reports upon working of those safeguards and all such reports are to be laid before each House of Parliament along with Memorandum explaining the Action Taken or propose to be taken on the recommendations relating to the Union and the reasons for non-acceptance, if any, of any of such recommendations.

- 2. In pursuance of the above constitutional mandate, Shri Jatothu Hussain, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes accompanied by Shri Ashok Lakkarasu, PS to Hon'ble Member (JH) visited Indian Institute of Science Education and Research to understand the nature of grievances of STs in Institute and redressal mechanism and to give certain recommendations for effective implementation of constitutional safeguards for the students and employees belonging to Scheduled Tribes.
- 3. Director, Sri Santanu Battacharya and Registrar Sri Vijaymohan Pillai and Deputy Registrar Sri Inderpreet Kohil have participated in the meeting.

4. The Commission has received certain representations from the Staff and ST Students with regard to the following issues.

As the Institute is newly established, the staffa re inadequate . There are 85 Teaching staff and 40 non teaching staff. Among Teaching staff there are 6 Professors, 50 Assistant Professors, 30 Associate Professors and 4 Deans. But among these only 2 STs are there that too in the Assistant Professors. Out of 40 Non Teaching staff none of them are STs.

The Agency called Srinivasa Brothers is engaged for hiring the outsourcing staff. There is negligible representation of STs in the outsourcing staff. Out of 70 Housekeeping staff, there are negligible number of STs

The Outsouring staff are not given the casual leaves though there is a provision of 15 days casual leaves for the outsourcing staff.

Out of 5 Drivers there are 2 ST Drivers

There is No ST Association, Association office and Liason officer . There is no Ambedkar Bhavan

There are no monthly grievance day and quarterly grievance meetings held by the management.

Students

The Students have represented the book bank fot STs in library

Quality and quantity of food in Hostels is not satisfactory according to the students.

The medical care is by the weekly visit of the doctor . The students represented for regular availability of the doctor

There is no transportation facility for the students and staff


Recommendations

The CPWD may expedite the works of buildings, Access roads and Ground immediately.

C The play Ground, Cricket stadium and volleyball stadium may be made on the campus

The CGPA Grading system may be made scientifically as many S and ST students have represented that they are being discriminated.

The Management may pursue the grant of scholarships from the Ministry as many a times the applications are being rejected for various reasons.



5. The Commission desires that the Director and Registrar should dispose off the grievances highlighted in a time bound manner. The NCST will continue to provide support in addressing these challenges.
