Sub: Application filed by Shri Hari Shankar Meena (ST) for extension of time to join his newly appointed post of Inspector, Central Excise at Chennai Zone –reg.

In continuation of this Commission's letter of even number dated 19-3-2015 vide which a copy of the proceedings of the sitting held in the Commission on 20-2-2015 were forwarded for compliance on the application filed by Shri Hari Shankar Meena, Village Dedarauli, Post – Vajheda, Tehsil-Hindon, District Karauli, Rajasthan, Staff Selection commission (SSC) New Delhi vide their letter No. 4/30/2014-P&P-I dated 17-4-2015 has intimated to the Commission that though the delay by SSC, Chennai in forwarding the proposal to HQs is highly regrettable, it does not materially affect the case as the fact remains that the candidate did not join duty within the maximum period of six months from the date of original offer of appointment on 4-12-2013 as per DoP&T No. 35015/2/93-Estt.(D) dated 9-8-1995 and contrary to the advice given by the Commission, requested the Commission to review its advice.

- 2. In this connection it is mentioned that no decision has been conveyed to the applicant till date either by the Staff Selection Commission, Chennai Regional Office or HQs Office, New Delhi on his request submitted well in time to extend date of joining in his place of posting on account of his mother's illness which this Commission feels is quite genuine and there are proof that he booked his air tickets to reach his place of duty, but had to be cancelled at the last moment. It is also observed that Commissioner, Central Excise, Chennai is willing to accept the joining of the applicant, if SSC extends the joining date in the interest of revenue and as there is shortage of ST candidates.
- 3. Hon'ble Vice Chairperson, NCST has taken a very serious view of the whole matter and has considered this action of SSC as an act of atrocity on a Scheduled Tribe candidate and has therefore desired that he would like to have a sitting in this case with the Chairman, SSC in person on 25-5-2015 at 3.00PM in the Commission in accordance with the powers vested in him under the provisions of Article 338-A of the Constitution of India.
